WebIn MLA style, use a simplified form of the publisher's name. Omit any articles (A, An, The), any business abbreviations (Co., Inc.), words that mean publisher (Books, House, Press). If the publisher's name is a person's name (such as William B. Eerdmans), include only the last name (Eerdmans).
